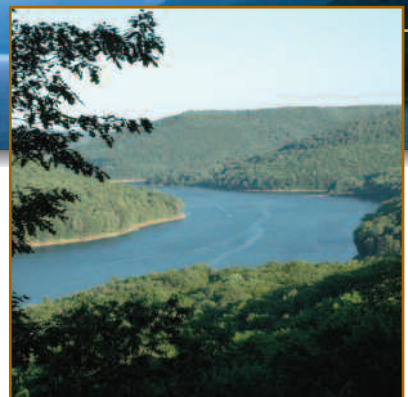
## You're on the Trail to Something BIG

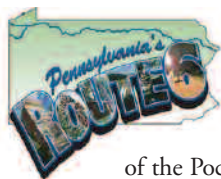
**Allegheny National Forest** – Are you ready to leave the everyday traffic and hustle and bustle of voicemail, email and urban life behind? If so, immerse yourself in lush green forests and quiet uncrowded spaces in this peaceful nature escape. Here you can enjoy hiking, biking, boating and fishing along the grand Allegheny Reservoir. Campsites and cabins, guided tours, boat, kayak and canoe rentals are also offered at Willow Bay and an extensive trail system is also waiting to be experienced by all skill levels.

**Kinzua Viaduct Sky Walk** – Soaring over 220 feet above Kinzua Creek, these nine historic towers remain from the structure following a tornado of 2003 and are currently being reinvented. Here you will be able to overlook the panoramic vistas of the Kinzua Gorge. Hiking, beautiful picnic grounds and spectacular nature programs welcome each visitor at the Kinzua Bridge State Park which is easily accessible via the Kinzua Bridge Scenic Byway.
